



### 1880's VICTORIAN PAPER DOLLS (*Makes 3 Jointed Dolls*)

Print on glossy photo inkjet paper. Smooth a thin layer of white glue on back side of the paper. Glue to light-weight cardboard and cut out each piece. Carefully punch holes with a small hole punch exactly as indicated on each piece. Punch a hole in the head & shoulder piece by lining it up with the torso and using the torso holes for placement. Assemble doll with torso as back layer. Put mini gold circle brads through all the holes to create jointed dolls. They can now be dressed imaginatively with fabric, lace and paper.
